About The Camp

The Oxford College of Emory University All-Sport Camp provides a safe, fun, and rewarding experience for campers ages 6-15.

Our experienced and highly trained camp staff will supervise your children from drop-off until pick-up. This innovative and unique camp can accommodate children at all skill levels. With our low staff to camper ratio, we are able to make safety our highest priority.



The majority of activity takes place inside the air-conditioned Williams Gymnasium Building. Campers come inside for water and to cool down after activities. Water is provided at every activity location.

Safety is our highest priority and we are well-staffed with certified lifeguards for all pool activities.

In addition, a member of our Oxford College of Emory University sports medicine staff is on duty during all camp activities.

Each of the instructional activity areas is led by a professional adult coordinator who is a member of the Oxford College of Emory University teaching/coaching staff.

Our camp is different from many other camps due to the number of professional adults actively working at the camp. Have your child learn from the best!



Daily Schedule

Camp begins promptly at 9:00 am. In the morning, campers rotate through 45 minute instructional activity areas each day.

At 12:00pm, campers break for lunch. Campers must bring a sack lunch from home and will be supervised as they eat lunch in an air conditioned room.

At approximately 1:00 pm, the campers continue a wide variety of age-appropriate activities that are different from the morning offerings, rotating through two more 45 minute instructional activity areas

At about 2:30 pm all campers will participate in one big group activity.

Campers may be picked up between 3:00pm and 3:15 pm.
